

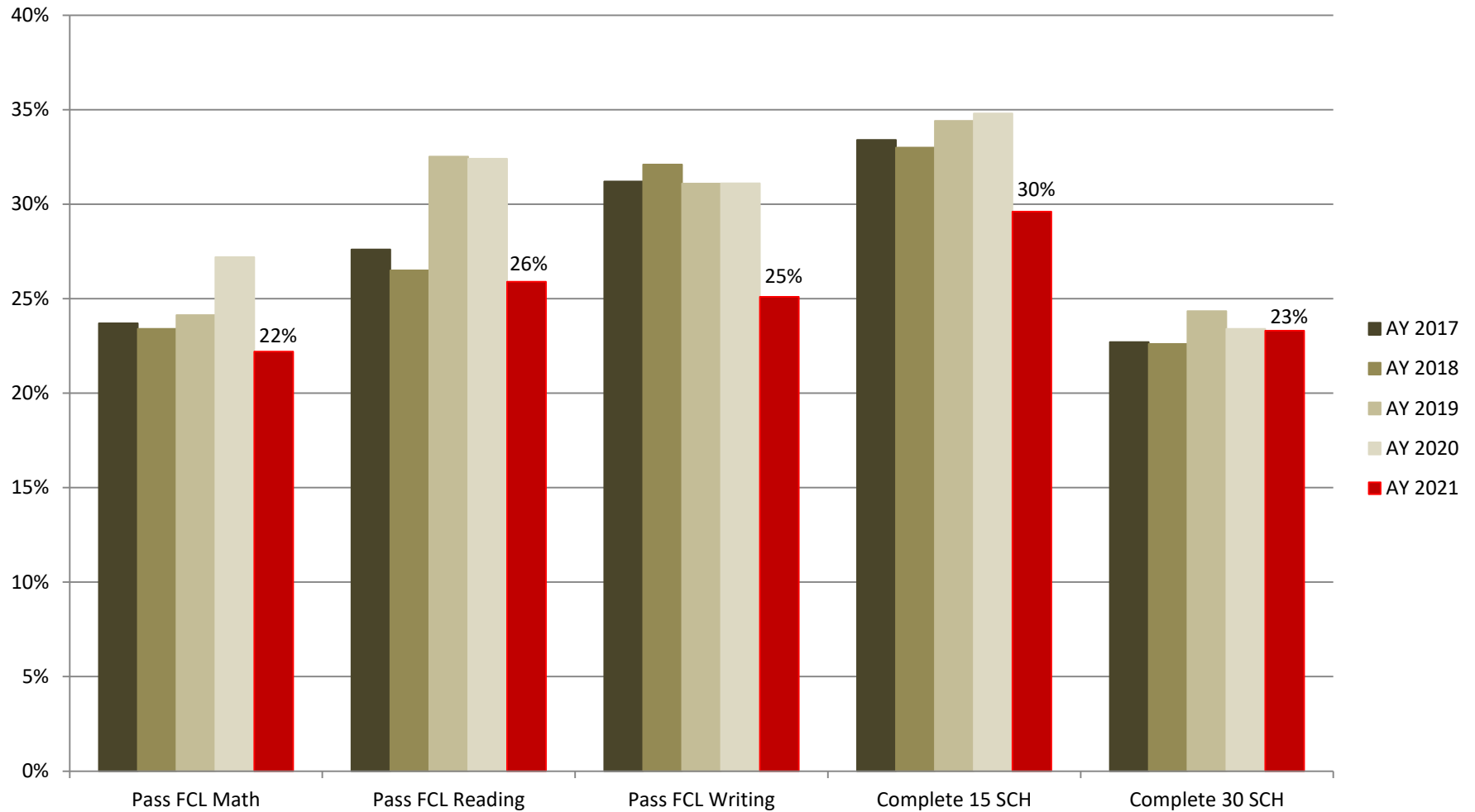

### First College-Level<sup>1</sup> and Semester Credit Hour Completions<sup>2</sup>; AY 2017 – AY 2021



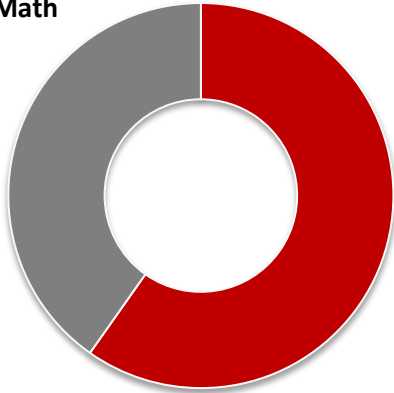

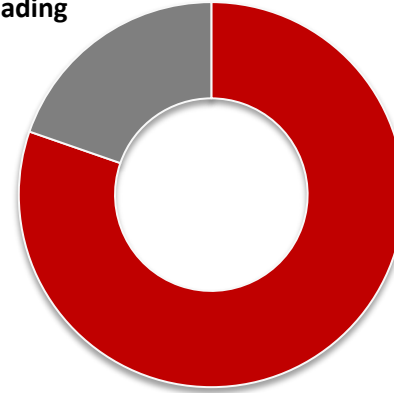
### TSI Obligation Met<sup>3</sup>; Fall 2019 Cohort

Statewide Avg = 43.3%

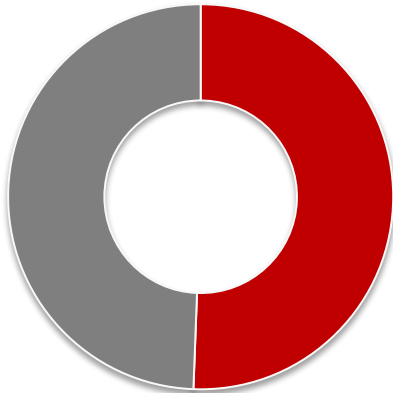
TSI Satisfied – Reading

Statewide Avg = 57.1%

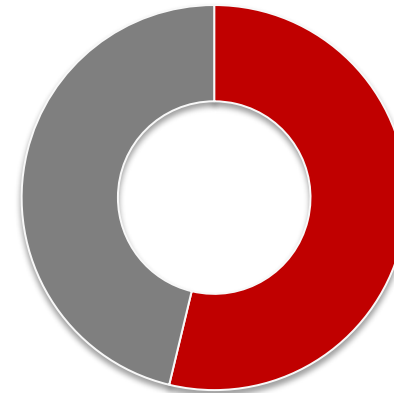
### Completed College Course<sup>4</sup>; Fall 2019 Cohort

Completed Course – Reading



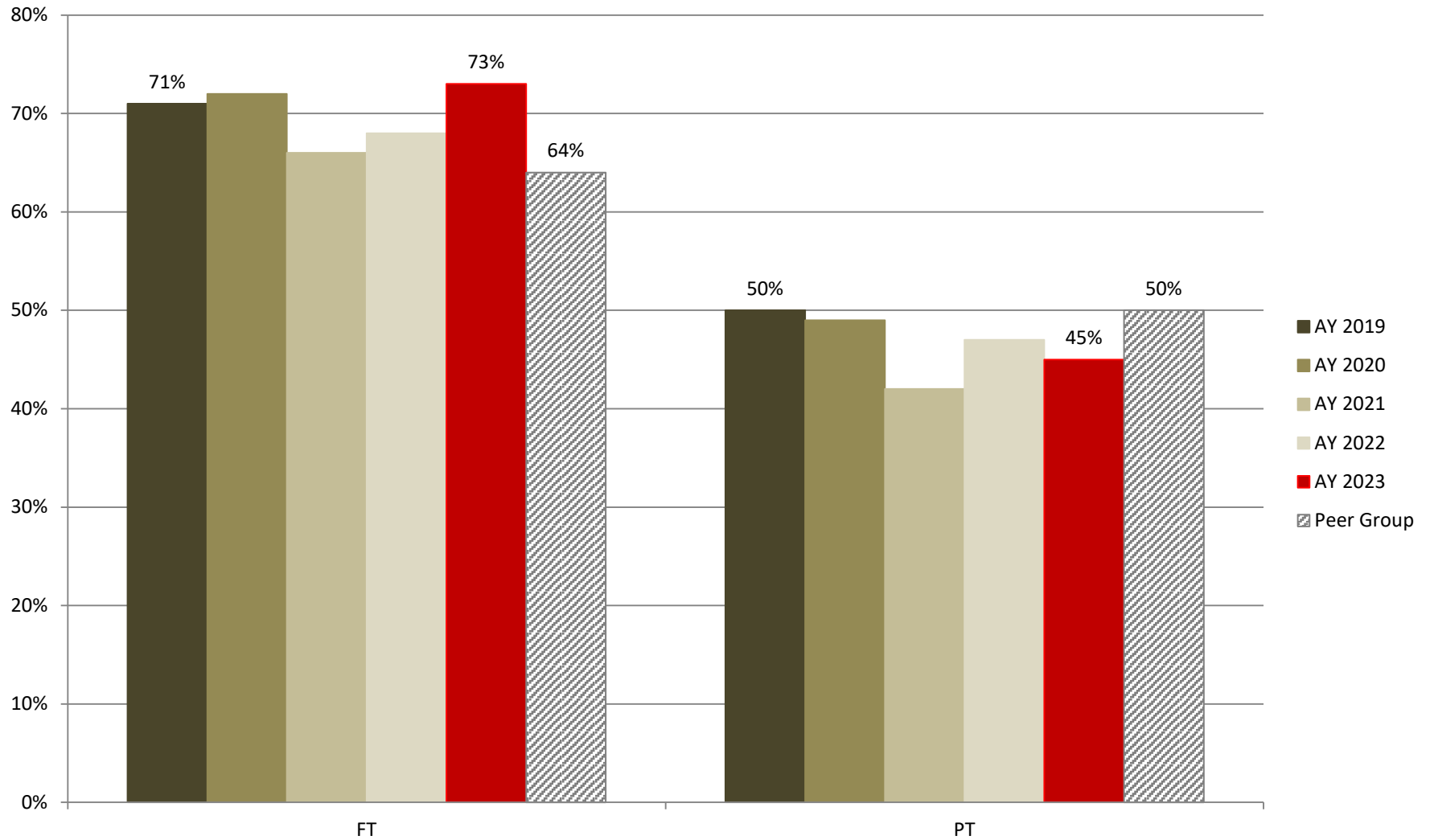

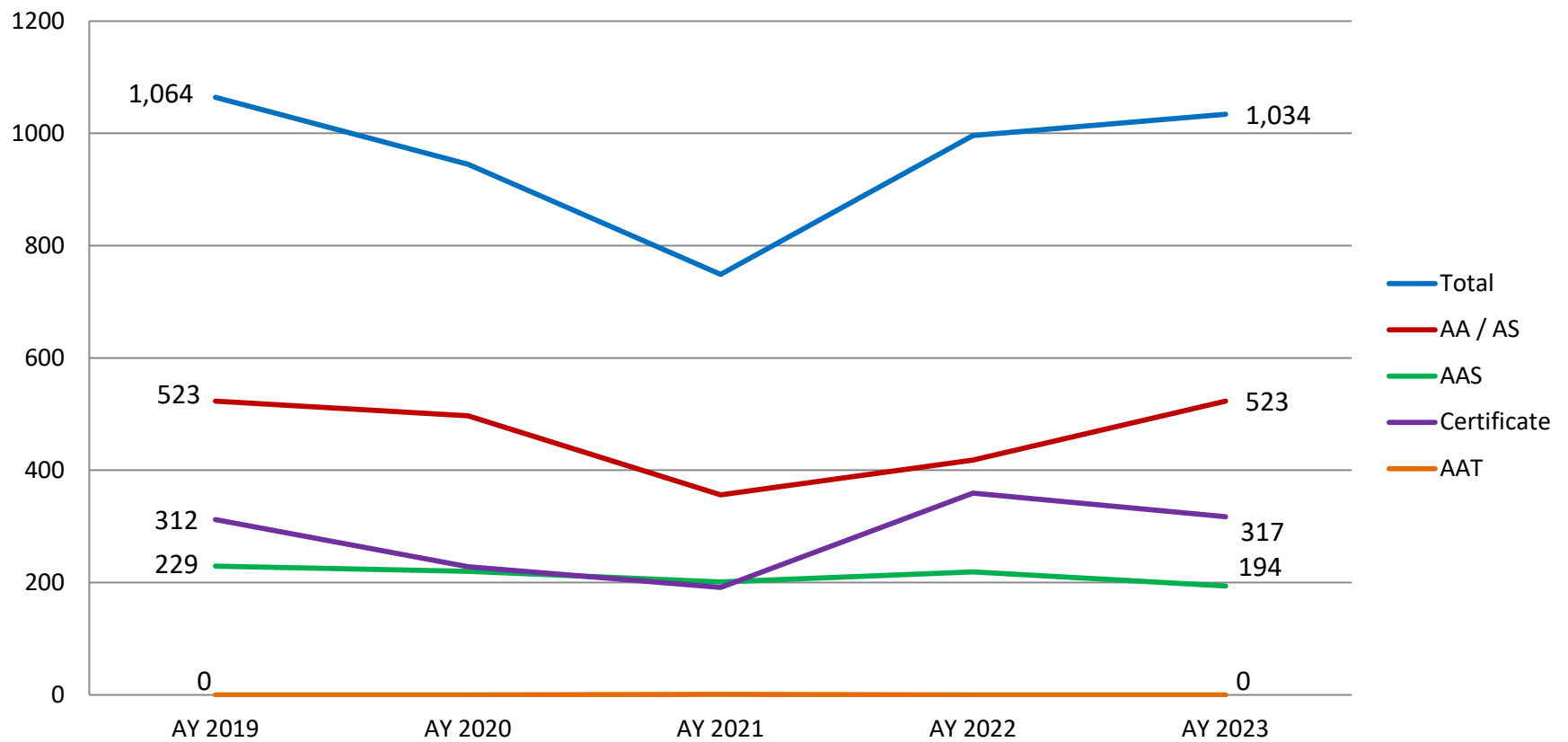
First-Time in College Retention Rates (Fall to Fall); AY 2019 – AY 2023 (Cohort beginning the previous Fall)

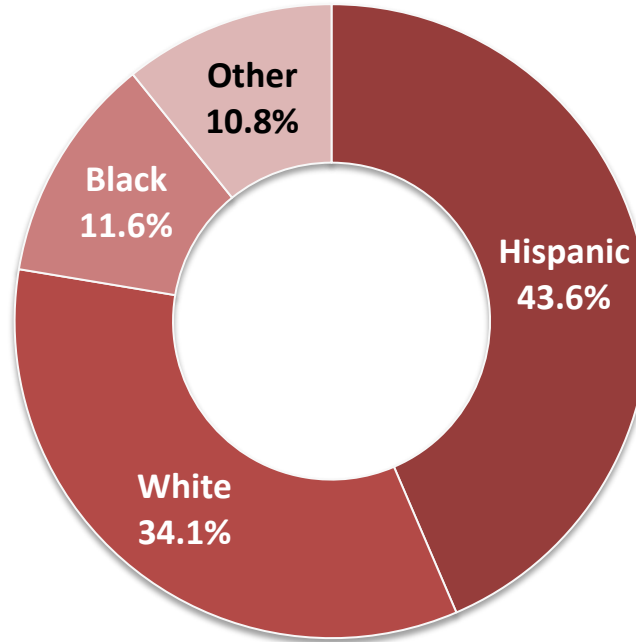

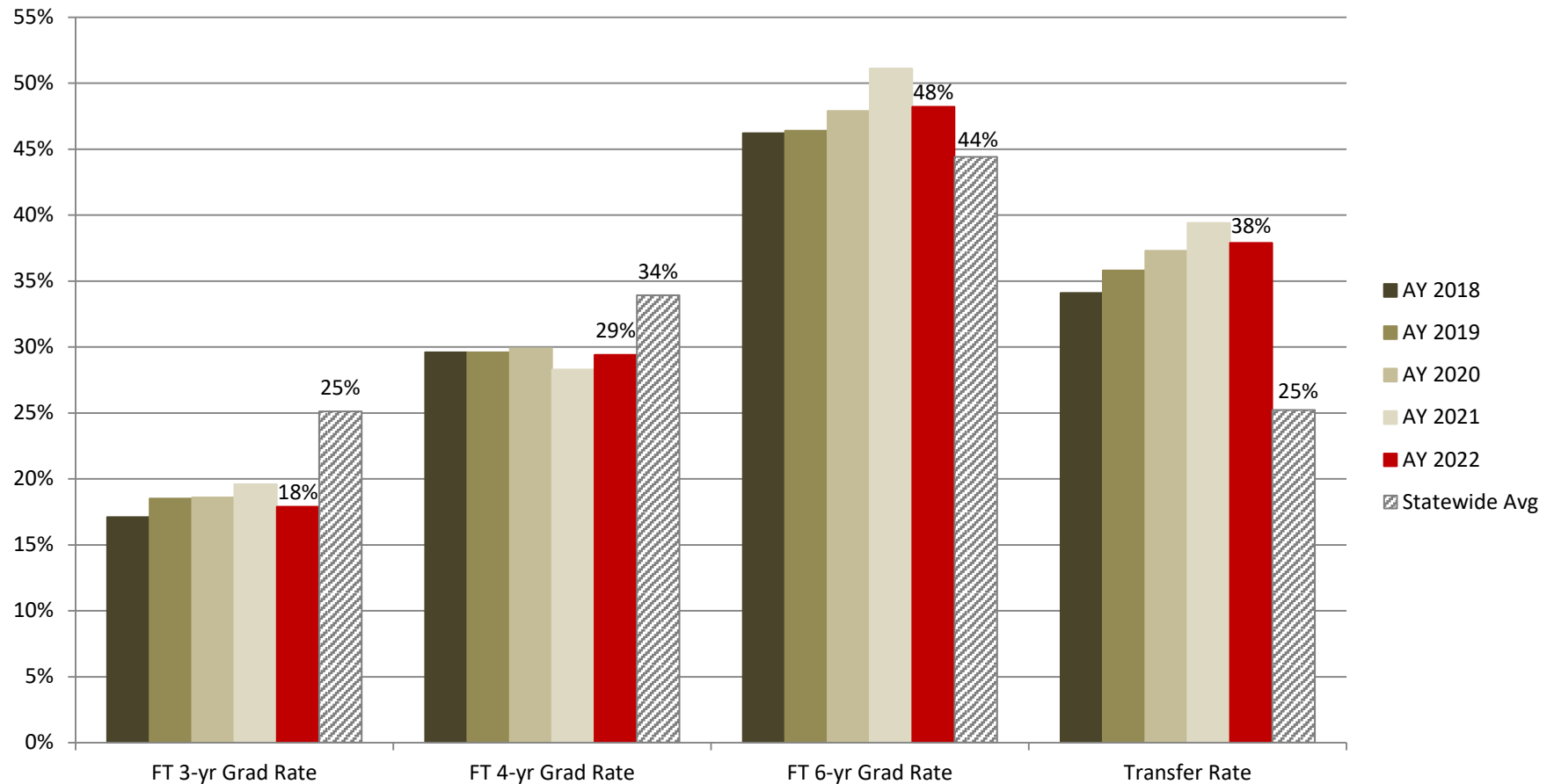

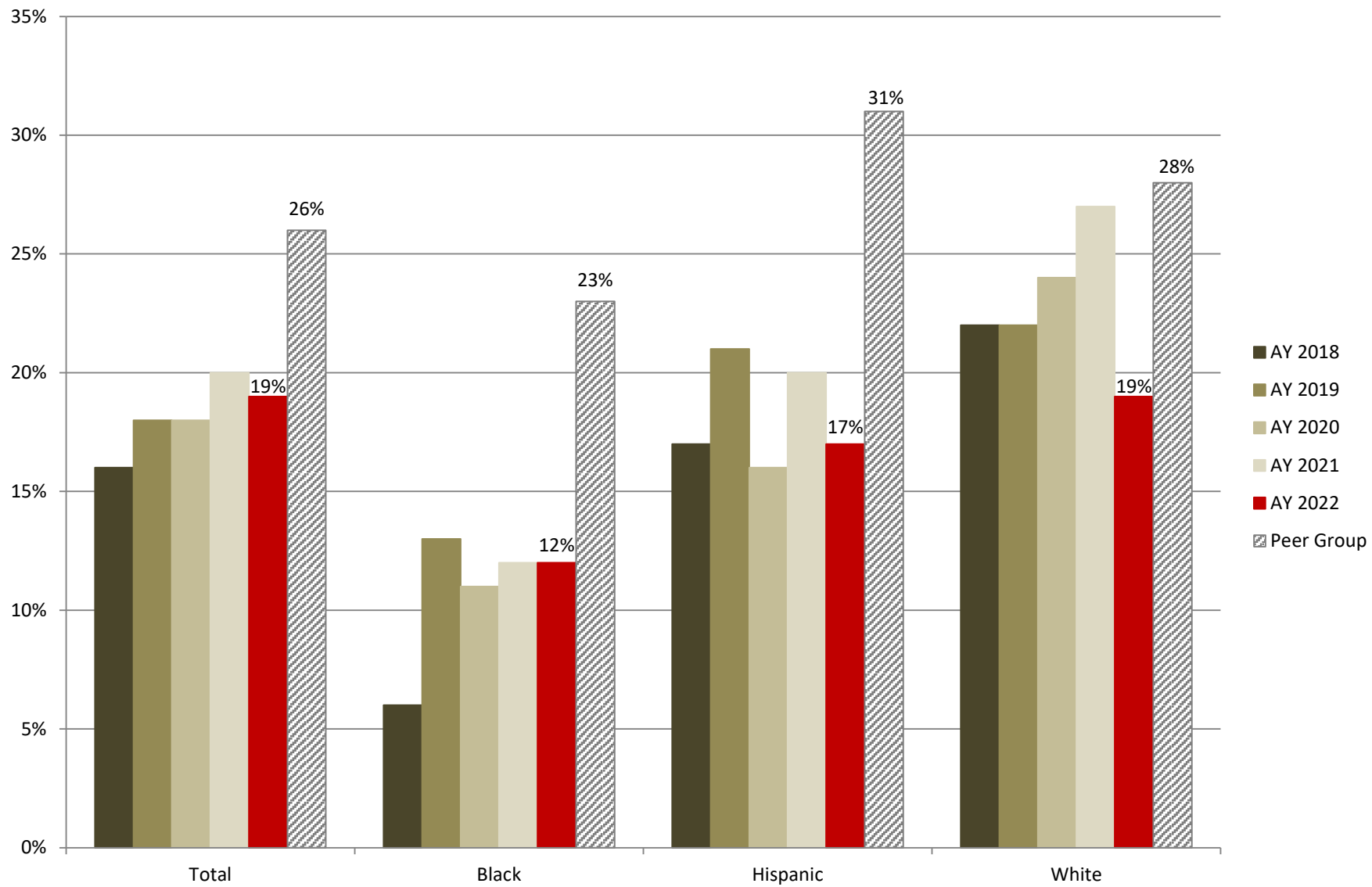
### Graduation<sup>5</sup> and Transfer<sup>6</sup> Rates; AY 2018 – AY 2022



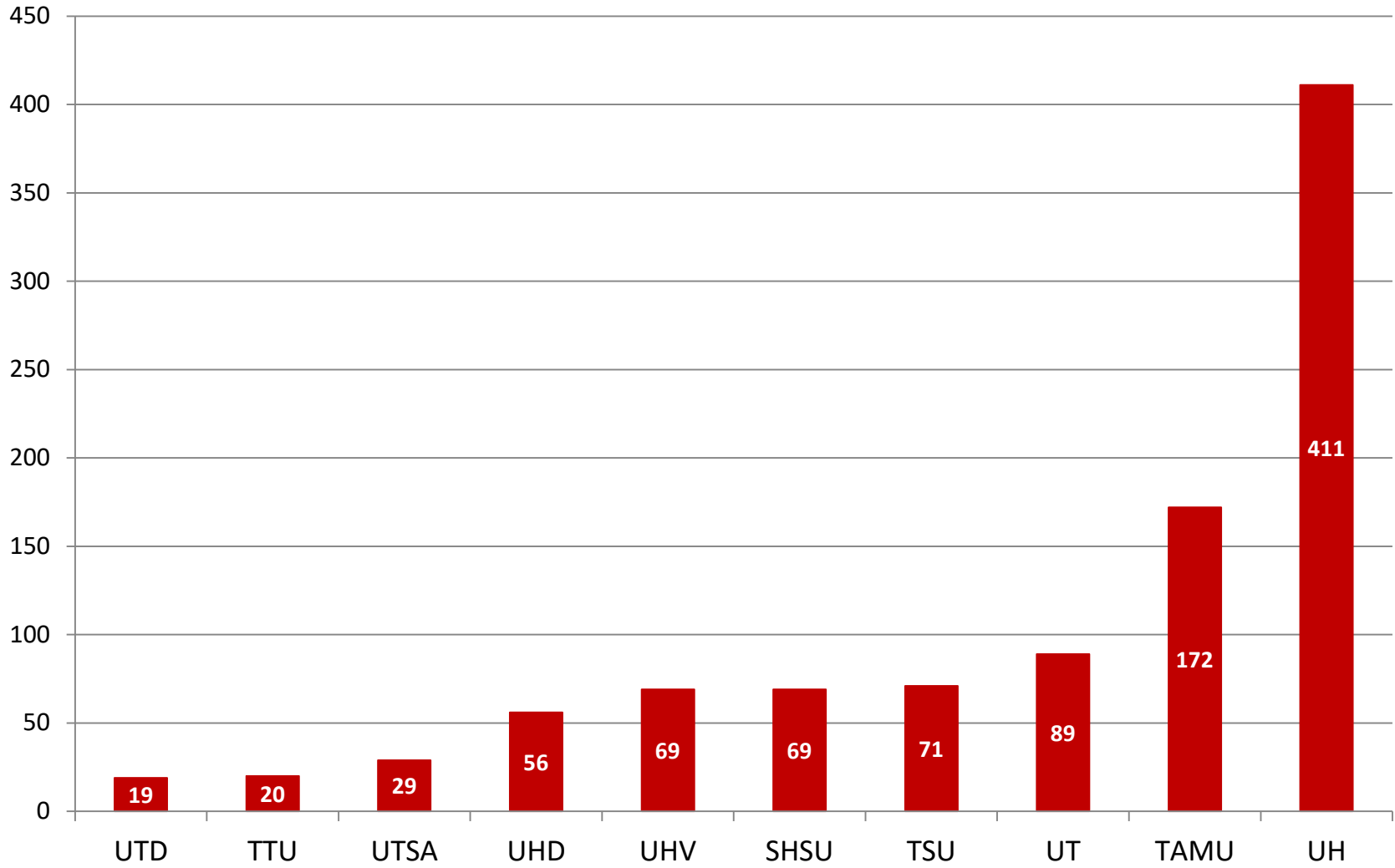
