



Instructions

To receive federal financial aid, a student must verify their identity and sign the Statement of Educational Purpose. This can be done in person at WCJC or, if that is not possible, through a notarized form submission.

In-Person Verification

A student must appear in person at Wharton County Junior College and present a valid, unexpired, government-issued photo identification (e.g., driver's license, state ID, or passport). WCJC will copy the ID, annotate it with the date received, and record the name of the official who collected it. The student must sign the Statement of Educational Purpose in the presence of the WCJC official.

If Unable to Appear in Person

If you cannot appear in person, you must submit:

1. A copy of an unexpired valid government-issued photo ID acknowledged in a notary statement.
2. This original form with the Statement of Educational Purpose completed and notarized.
3. The notarized original form must be mailed or delivered to WCJC (scanned or copied forms are not accepted).
