

Major Pathway Course Override Approval

Students must consult with an academic advisor, division head, or program director and receive that person's signature prior to registering for a course outside their major pathway.

WCJC students are allowed to enroll in a course that is not a part of their major pathway. However, consequences may result from taking courses that are not designated for their major pathway. Potential consequences include:

- Federal financial aid, including Veterans' Benefits, cannot be awarded for any course that is outside of a student's designated major pathway.
- Federal financial aid appeals are voided and financial aid is forfeited for taking a course outside of a major pathway and approved academic plan.
- Courses taken outside of a major pathway will count toward the total number of credits attempted, affecting future financial aid eligibility.
- No refund will be given to students who enroll and later seek a refund due to the course being outside of their major pathway.
- Courses not aligned with a student's major pathway may not count toward graduation requirements.
- Courses outside of a major pathway may not transfer to another institution or be accepted for credit within that institution's program(s) of study.
