Purpose

The College shall develop procedures for student admissions.

Procedure

Wharton County Junior College (WCJC) has an open admissions policy that allows all persons the opportunity to enroll in and benefit from postsecondary education.

Each applicant must satisfactorily complete all applicable phases of the admission process, including:

- Complete an online ApplyTexas application for Texas Two Year/Community Colleges.
- Submit all official high school and/or college transcripts or GED certificate.
- Complete testing requirements, as required by the Texas Success Initiative.
- Submit a record of bacterial meningitis vaccination or exemption, if applicable.

Specific application requirements for various student types, including “New, First-Time”, “Dual Credit”, “Transfer”, and “Transient”, are published in the WCJC College Catalog and on the WCJC website at <https://wcjc.edu/Admissions/admissions-and-registration/Admissions-Requirements.aspx>.

Admission for credit study programs is open to all applicants who meet at least one the method of regular admission. Students who are academically under-prepared may be required to enroll in developmental courses in accordance with the Texas Success Initiative rules and regulations.

Admission to the college does not imply admission to all college programs. Guidelines for admission to select college programs are published in the WCJC College Catalog, available on the WCJC website, and on the individual program webpages, which can be found at <https://www.wcjc.edu/Programs/>.
