Petition for Credit – CLEP
(College Level Examination Program)

Students interested in taking a CLEP test should first visit the College Board website to view available tests and testing rules and procedures. The student can then call the WCJC Testing Center where he/she wants to test to schedule a testing date and time. Once the date and time have been established, the student can register for the exam through the “My Account” feature on the College Board website.

Students who want to petition for credit at WCJC based on CLEP scores should refer to the WCJC College Catalog or the chart below to view the subject test scores accepted by WCJC. Students can also check the WCJC website at WCJC.EDU – ADMISSIONS – TESTING – CLEP for more information, including payment details and test day procedures.

Credit for selected courses at Wharton County Junior College may be obtained by special examinations in accordance with the following policies:

- Credit by examination may not be acquired in courses in which the student is or has been enrolled for credit past the 12th class day of each semester or in an academic discipline in which the student has earned credit in a more advanced course.
- No credit by examination is applicable until the student has earned an equivalent number of hours at Wharton County Junior College.
- Not more than sixteen semester hours may be earned by examinations in transfer courses or more than twenty-two semester hours in vocational-technical courses.
- Grade of “P” Passing will be granted with credit in the course(s).
- CLEP exams are given on an appointment basis at the Wharton, Richmond, and Sugar Land campuses.
